### YUKON PRESBYTERIANS FOR EARTH CARE

Sign a Petition to Protect the Chuitna River Salmon Habitat The Yukon Presbyterians for Earth Care (YPEC) invite all of our presbytery members to sign a petition that will protect the salmon in the Chuitna River. The State of Alaska announced February 23rd that they will be deciding whether water should be left in the Chuitna River for salmon, or diverted to allow an Outside mining company to completely destroy the river for a coal mine. The proposed Chuitna coal mine would devastate the people, salmon, and wildlife that rely on the river system and the YPEC believes it is not in the best interest of Alaskans to trade wild salmon for coal. In order to protect Alaska's subsistence, commercial and recreational fishing opportunities it is essential that we maintain enough water in our streams to sustain our healthy fish populations. YPEC is not against all mining, but is against mining that will destroy our salmon streams. Furthermore, not only would this mine destroy the salmon stream but our research shows that in order for us to preserve our climate, 80 % of fossil fuels should never be consumed but left in the ground. The Chuitna Coal Mine would undermine our need for a healthy climate in the future.
