The Office of the General Assembly produced a succinct summary of actions taken at General Assembly last week. This is a good article for allowing your congregations to catch an overview of what happened at GA.

Being a summary, it does not include every action taken over eight days. Note that the overture offered by the Presbytery of Yukon did pass, though it did not make this summary. We therefore add to the GA summary that previous moderator Rick Ufford-Chase spoke out on Yukon's overture. Chase called the Yukon overture the "sleeper action of the 223rd General Assembly." He believed that this overture not only addresses race, but also the future of the church in a multi-cultural world.
