

Celebration of New Testament Translation

Last month we celebrated the first-ever complete translation of the New Testament into the St. Lawrence Island Yupik language. Celebrations were held in Gambell on Sunday 9/16, Savoonga on Monday 9/17, and Nome on Wednesday, 9/19. The translation work began in 1959 and ended in 2018.

Beulah Nowpakahok (second photo) was the last in a series of the chief translators. Dave Shinen (1st photo, 2nd from right) and his wife, Mitzi, oversaw the project from the beginning, starting in 1959, and were able to see it through to the end. Many, many others participated. And many churches (Presbyterian, Seventh Day, Covenant, United Methodist, Lutheran, others?) participated in the dedication.
